

ATTENDANCE CHALLENGE

Last week (wb 10.11.25) we had a total of **162 pupils with improving attendance** (up from 161 the previous week).

Unfortunately we have 129 pupils with a declining attendance trend, including moving from green to amber or red band or from amber to red band. This is mainly due to sickness, and includes 59 pupils from Y1 and Y2 who were particularly badly affected with illness last week.

Please remember that to avoid sicness spreading we operate a 24 hour rule. Pupils should not return to school until 24 hours after the last time they have been sick.

Mrs Davies will be contacting the parents and carers of pupils to offer support in helping them to help improve thier child's attendance moving forward.

SCHOOL SECURITY SCHOOL GATES

We are aware of your concerns regarding an increase in incidents in the local area close to the school, and have been working with our trust, Endeavour Academies, to update our security arrangements. A further incident on the afternoon of Friday 7th November has accelerated these plans.

We are in the process of purchasing electronic gates for the pedestrian gates and vehicle gates at our Barnaby Avenue entrance, near the school car park. These gates will be fully closed during the day, with the school being accessed via an intercom system controlled by our school reception. This installation will require some building work onsite and we estimate that it will be ready in the new year.

In the short term, until the new gate arrives, the existing gates at the Barnaby Avenue entrance will be closed between 8:45am and 2:30pm every day.

Visitors wishing to access site will need to telephone our school reception (01642 804101) who will contact a member of staff to open the gate.

The gate will be opened and manned by a member of staff between 11:20am and 12:40pm to allow Pre-school and Nursery drop off and pickup, and again at 2.30pm - 2.45pm to allow access to the visitor car park.

Please be aware that during the school day access will continue to only be available through the Barnaby Avenue entrance gates. The gates at Heywood Street and Ayresome Green Lane will continue to be locked closed from 8.55am-2.45pm to help keep our school site secure.

The safety of your children is our number one priority, and we are confident that this will offer significantly enhanced security.

This arrangement has been running successfully from Tuesday 11th November. We will keep you informed about progress on the installation of new gates and will review our procedures again once the new gates are installed.



Middlesbrough Council Primary School Admissions Reception Intake September 2026

Children start primary school full-time in the academic year in which they turn 5 years of age. The first class they attend is called Reception class.

If your child was born between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022, they will start primary school Reception class in September 2026.

You can apply for a primary school Reception place online using the Middlesbrough Council Citizen Portal.

Click HERE to access the Middlesbrough Council Citizen Portal.

The website is open for applications between 14 November 2025 and 15 January 2026. You can find out more in the timetable below.

Your child won't automatically be given a school place - you have to apply.

In November 2025, Middlesbrough Council will send you an application pack by post, which will tell you how to apply.

June and July 2026	Appeals heard by independent panels.
