

ATTENDANCE CHALLENGE

Each week all pupils with 100% attendance for the week are awarded an **Attendance Challenge Token** which they then place in our token jars. There is one token jar for EYFS, one for KS1 and one for KS2.

This week you will receive an invitation to attend from the class teacher. If you are unable to make your allocated time please contact the school office so an alternative mutually convenient time can be arranged.




FOCUS ON HISTORY


