



Triangulation Meetings Start This Week

A triangulation meeting is a focused meeting between a teacher, parents/carers and pupil and is a fantastic opportunity to further develop this relationship.

The meeting focuses on learning and is a great opportunity for you to meet your child's teacher to discuss their targets, attainment and next steps. It is a time for you to share and celebrate your child's achievements and find out how you can help them reach their full potential.

Our class teachers are looking forward to meeting all their pupils with their parents/carers at these meetings.

It is a great opportunity for parents and carers to see their child's classroom and find out about what and how they will be learning in their new year group

Meetings will take place after school this week and next week.

You should have received an invitation to attend from the class teacher. If you are unable to make your allocated time please contact the school office so an alternative mutually convenient time can be arranged.

For safeguarding reasons, please enter and leave the school building through the main entrance.

During our Triangulation Meetings we will be conducting a survey of parents and carers to find out what you like about our school and what you think could be improved.

There will be one questionnaire for each pupil so, for example, if you have three children you can complete three questionnaires. The questionnaire for each year group will be on a different coloured paper to help us with analysing the results and feeding back outcomes.

You can complete the questionnaire whilst you are in school and leave it with the teacher or can take it away to complete at home and return it to the school office.

ATTENDANCE CHALLENGE

Each week all pupils with 100% attendance for the week are awarded an **Attendance Challenge Token** which they then place in our token jars.

Last week (wb 29.9.25) we had a total of 131 pupils with improving attendance (up from 109 the previous week). This figure includes 21 pupils whose attendance improved enough to move from red attendance band to amber attendace band and one Y4 pupil who moved from amber to green band. Well done!

Unfortunately we have 47 pupils with a declining attendance trend, including moving from green to amber or red band or from amber to red band.
