ATTENDANCE CHALLENGE

Each week all pupils with 100% attendance for the week are awarded an **Attendance Challenge Token** which they then place in our token jars. There is one token jar for EYFS, one for KS1 and one for KS2.

Last week we had **326 pupils** with 100% attendance for the week which is 18 more than the previous week! Each will receive a token to place in their token jar. Well done!

Last week (wb 1.12..25) we had a total of **246 pupils with improving attendance** (up from 228 the previous week). This figure includes 7 pupils whose attendance improved enough to move from red attendance band to amber attendance band and equals over 62% of our school. Well done!

Unfortunately we have 62 pupils with a declining attendance trend, including moving from green to amber band or amber to red band.

This year we are pleased to once again invite parents and carers into school to watch our end of term performances. In order to keep everyone safe and ensure we have enough space, admission will be by ticket only.

Each pupil will receive two tickets. Tickets will be sent out later in the week on See Saw. If you have yet to download or access seesaw and need support to do so, please ask your child's teacher for an access code or ask at the school office.

Paper tickets will be available if you are unable to access the SeeSaw app.

Please be aware that for all performances:

- There is no space in the hall for pushchairs.** Babies can be carried, and the pushchair left in the entrance area, however, if your baby starts to cry and disturb the performance you may be asked to take the baby out of the hall.
- If you require disabled or wheelchair access to the performance, please let the school office know in advance** so arrangements can be made to accommodate this.
- The performance will start promptly and there will be no admission to the hall once the performance has started.**
- If you need to leave the performance, you will not be allowed to re-enter the hall.**
- There will be enough seats for all ticket holders. **You are expected to remain seated throughout the performance. Standing room will be at the back of the hall only.** Under no circumstances will you be allowed to stand at the sides of the hall. This is for safety reasons.
- There will be photograph opportunities at the end of each performance. **Please do not take photographs or videos during the performances.** This is for safeguarding reasons.

Middlesbrough Council Primary School Admissions Reception Intake September 2026

Children start primary school full-time in the academic year in which they turn 5 years of age. The first class they attend is called Reception class.

If your child was born between 1st September 2021 and 31st August 2022, they will start primary school Reception class in September 2026.

You can apply for a primary school Reception place online using the Middlesbrough Council Citizen Portal. Click [HERE](#) to access the Middlesbrough Council Citizen Portal.

The website is open for applications between 14 November 2025 and 15 January 2026. You can find out more in the timetable below.

Your child won't automatically be given a school place - you have to apply.

In November 2025, Middlesbrough Council will send you an application pack by post, which will tell you how to apply.

If you do not get an application pack, please contact the school admissions team.

It's your responsibility as a parent or guardian to apply for a school place at the right time.

Timetable for Primary School Admissions September 2026 intake

14 November 2025	Application packs sent to parents with details of how to apply. Online applications open.
15 January 2026	Closing date for online and paper applications. Closing date for applications to defer entry to Reception for one year.
16 April 2026	Letters and emails sent to inform parents of their child's school place. Letters are sent by 2nd Class post.
June and July 2026	Appeals heard by independent panels.

If you need support to access the admissions procedures or complete the forms, please contact the school office in the first instance.

If English is not your first language our admin team can put you in touch with support from Middlesbrough EMAT team.

We ask that **no more than two adults** attend per child as we do not have lots of space.

Children may wear a Christmas jumper or t-shirt, or something red/green with their school trousers or skirt. A reminder will be sent prior to the date
